NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

South of Perth Yacht Club
(Organising Authority)

The South of Perth Yacht Club (SoPYC) in conjunction with Virtual Regatta invite entries to the 2020 E-Sailing Club Consistency series held every Thursday.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Virtual Racing Rules of Sailing dated 22nd January 2019.
- 1.2 Rule infringements will be decided by the VR system and its decision are final and are not appealable.
- 1.3 There will be no protests for incidents while racing, any penalties will be applied by VR during the game.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Entry is open to all SoPYC Members.
- 2.2 Members may enter by registering online:

- 2.3 Entries close by 1000 Thursday mornings.
- 2.4 Entry to each race is restricted to the first 20 entries due to game limitations.

3. FEES

Entry is free.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1 The regatta will consist of up to 4 races sailed back to back.

5. EQUIPMENT

The equipment to be sailed will be the J70.

6. VENUE

- 6.1 The location of the racing area will be determined by the Race Officer of the day before the first race of the day and remain until all races have been completed.
- 6.2 Attachment B shows the location of each regatta harbour.

7. COURSE

- 7.1 The diagram in Attachment A shows the course, including the approximate angles between legs, the order in which marks are to be passed, and the side on which each mark is to be left.
- 7.2 The course will be "Upwind Medium" – a windward/leeward course with an offset mark and a downwind finish. Two laps.
- 7.3 The race target time will be 6 minutes.

8. DROPPING OUT OF RACES

There shall be no redress for dropping out or failing to connect to a race for any reason.

9. SCORING

- 9.1 The Low Points Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.
- 9.2 One (1) race is required to be completed.
- 9.3 A boats series score will be the total of her race scores.

10. STARTING RACES

Races shall be started by using the following signals:

| Minutes before starting signal | Visual signal | Sound signal | Means |
|--------------------------------|------------------------------|--------------|--------------------|
| 1:15 | P & Virtual Regatta flag | One | Warning signal |
| 1:00 | P removed | One | Preparatory signal |
| 0:00 | Virtual Regatta flag removed | One | Starting signal |

11. PRIZES

- 11.1 A bucketful of virtual hugs and kisses to each series winner.

13. PARENTAL / GUARDIAN CONSENT

For all competitors under the age of 18 years of age at any time during the event, completing the online registration form will be deemed Parental/Guardian consent for entry to the Regatta.

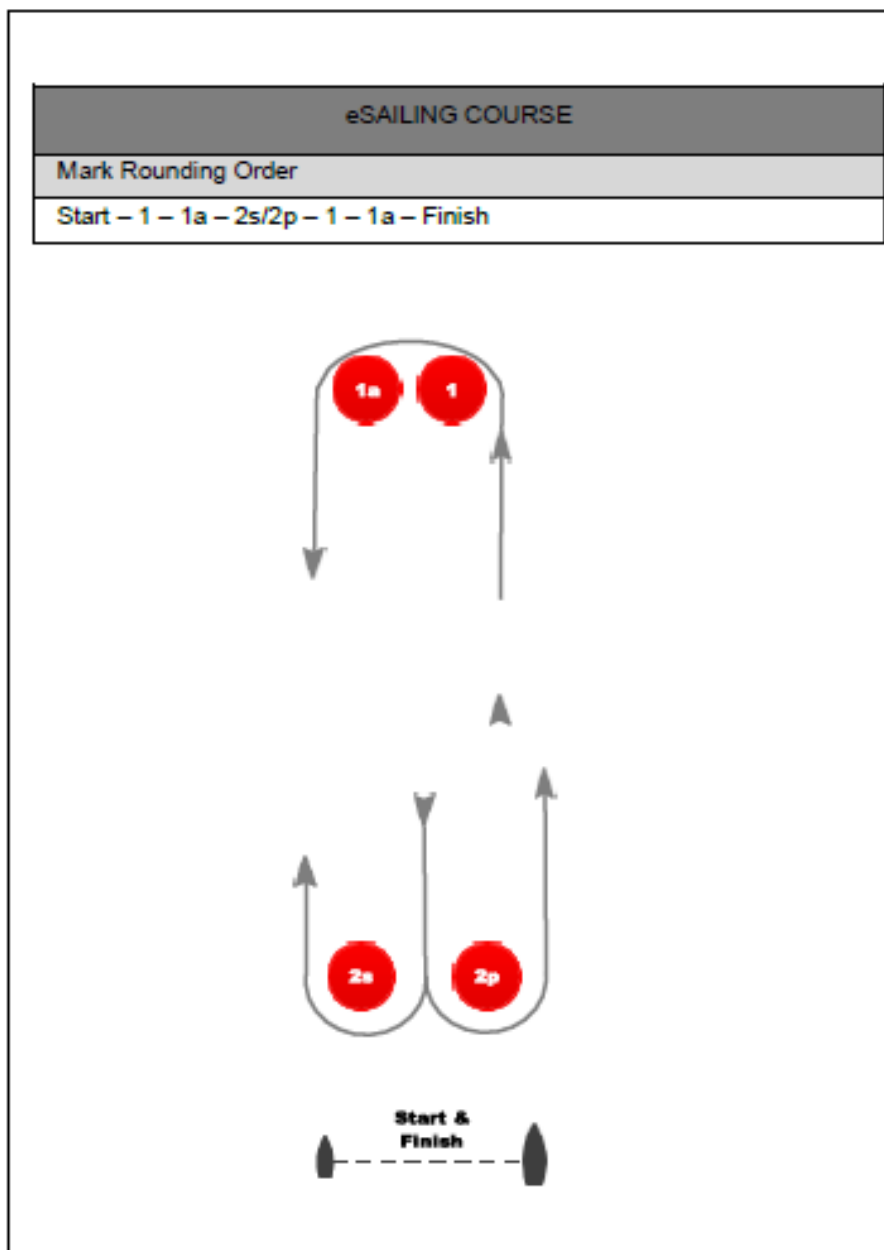
