

SoPYC SAILPASS POLICY

Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 46 PERSON IN CHARGE

From 1st January 2022, all persons on board a boat while racing shall be members of a Club affiliated to Australian Sailing and have an Australian Sailing number, or hold a valid **SailPass**, or if an international competitor, be a member of club affiliated to a World Sailing recognised Member National Authority.

SAILPASS MEMBERSHIP

Effective from Sunday 3rd October 2021 (SoPYC Opening Day), non-member competitors shall obtain a Day Membership SailPass available from On Water Group office or by using the 'Memberpoint' smart phone App before each race.

To download the Memberpoint App and purchase a SailPass for a day is free of charge. The number of SailPasses that can be purchased at SoPYC for each individual is limited to **15** before an annual membership subscription will be required.

Once downloaded, press the Memberpoint App and see the home screen...

STEP 3

Fill out a once-off registration form

Following your successful SailPass registration, you will instantly receive an email from Memberpoint with your username and password. Use this to access the Memberpoint App to purchase your sail passes and sign yourself on to your chosen boat.

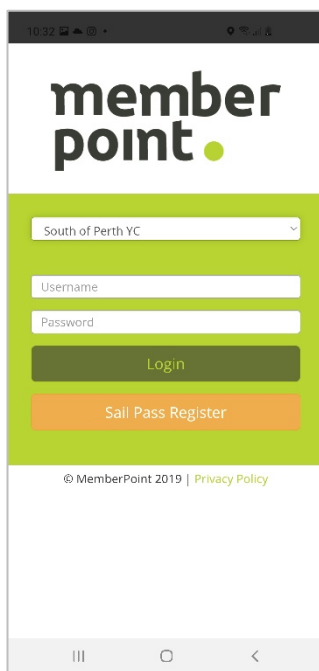
At the same time as your Sail Pass registration was submitted, your unique Australian Sailing Membership number was created. This may be checked via the Australian Sailing website:

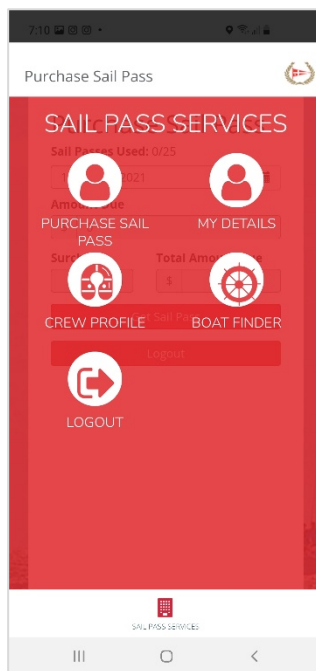
STEP 4

Use your new login details to access Memberpoint Services.



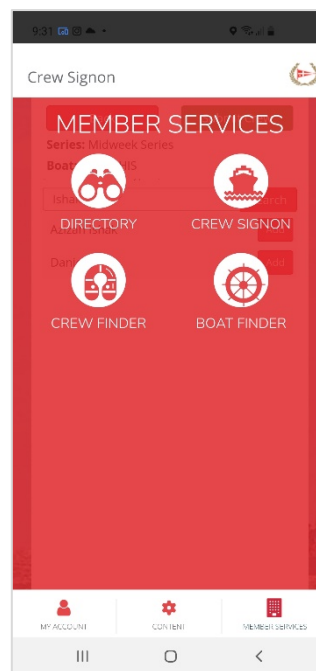
STEP 5

RACING AT SOUTH OF PERTH YACHT CLUB

Racing is conducted year-round. Here is what's on at the Club

Midweek Series	Keelboat races held every Wednesday throughout the year starting at 14:40 with a race duration of up to 2.5 hours. No Spinnakers permitted.
Twilight Series	Keelboat races held every Wednesday from November until March starting at 18:00 and finishing before sunset. No spinnakers permitted.
Saturday Series	Keelboat races held every Saturday from October until the end of April. Normally starting at 13:30 and finishing around 16:30. Spinnakers encouraged.
Frostbite Series	Keelboat racing held on alternating Sundays during the colder months from May until September starting at 13:30 and finishing no later than 1700. Spinnakers encouraged.
Off The Beach	Various junior, youth and senior Off The Beach classes competing every Sunday during the summer months and alternating Sundays during winter. Multiple races each day around inflatable marks on Melville Water starting at 13:30 until approximately 16:30.
